Subject: Increase in Residential Garbage Fees

Dear Residents,

Please be advised that effective immediately, the residential garbage fees will increase from \$20 to \$25. This adjustment is necessary due to rising transportation and landfill fees.

Additionally, we are pleased to inform you that bulk disposal at 612 S Camelia Blvd is free for all citizens of Fort Valley. To take advantage of this service, please provide a copy of your utility bill and identification matching your Fort Valley address. Bulk items, limbs, and leaves placed on curve are collected bi-weekly at no additional fee*.

Kindly disregard any previous notices regarding this matter.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

- *Items allowed curbside: leaves, straw, hedge, shrub, tree trimmings, grass and other inert materials resulting from general residential yard cleaning. White goods, (no more than 3 pieces per week per residence) such as carpet, appliances, furniture, mattresses, etc.
- Place yard waste curbside on regular household collection days.
- Make sure tree limbs are no larger than six inches in diameter. They can be any length.
- Stack tree limbs loosely with cut ends toward the street.
- Keep limb or brush piles no larger than 3x8x3 feet, the equivalent of a small pick-up truckload.
- When disposing of garden material, remember to shake off the dirt.
- Do not mix yard waste with household waste or other items.
- Remember, leaf and limb crews cannot pick up wood containing nails or metal, bags that weigh more than 50 lbs., logs, firewood, stumps, root balls, debris from major tree removal or land clearing, construction and demolition waste (i.e. windows, flooring, drywall, plywood).
- If you fail to do this you may be subject to penalties.
